ABOUT THE COMPETITION In celebration of Elton's *Farewell Yellow Brick Road* tour and in recognition of the multi-talented cartoonists of Australia, the National Cartoon Gallery is hosting The Captain Fantastic Cartoon Competition! This competition is open to cartoonists and artists in any medium... so grab your pens, pencils, chisels, paints... or the welding torch and get involved in the most exciting competition on the calendar! The exhibition of works will be displayed in the gallery at the Bunker from 31 January 2020—29 March 2020, coinciding with Elton's performances in Coffs Harbour. This is a great opportunity for artists to gain recognition and exposure for their works and is also an opportunity for up and coming artists to carve a name in the cartooning community. The National Cartoon Gallery is the only gallery of its kind in Australia and is supported and recognised by the Australian Cartoonists Association. Works may be travelled in a future exhibition with the artists' permission.

AWARDS AND PRIZES Elton Getaway package including: 2 x Tickets to Elton John *Farewell Yellow Brick Road*, Coffs Harbour Tue 25th Feb 2020 (Ruby Class) with 2 Nights accommodation for two at Opal Cove including breakfast • Elton John 3 pce vinyl collection • More Fabulous prizes yet to be announced. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY Entries must be a comical or satirical salute to Sir Elton John. There is no limit to the number of entries each person can submit. Entry fee is \$20 per artist. Payment will be accepted through cheque, EFT or in person at the gallery. Works can be any medium both 2D and 3D with a maximum size in any direction of 1 meter. By entering, the artist gives permission for the gallery to exhibit their artwork for the duration of the Captain Fantastic exhibition. All works chosen for exhibition are for sale, gallery commission is 25%.

COPYRIGHT: All works remain the property of the artist, however entrants may elect to have a copy of their entry catalogued into the National Cartoon Gallery collection. Please indicate your choice on the entry form. If the artist does choose to have their work added to the collection the following will apply: The gallery is permitted to reproduce the works in catalogue form for future exhibitions. The image may be used in full or part thereof for promotional material and publications for the gallery. The gallery may also sell copyright marked prints, for the purpose of raising funds to support the gallery. Sale cartoons are printed in A3 or A4 as appropriate, on 200gsm card at 600 x 600 dpi photo quality setting using a Canon Image Runner Advance C5240 Printer (or better/equal equivalent). Further sales of prints online or on products other than prints to be permitted only by prior agreement with the individual artist.

ENTRY DETAILS: A completed entry form must accompany works. If submitting multiple entries only one entry form is required. The entry form must make reference to each work individually. Entries will be accepted digitally, by post (Po Box 1483 Coffs Harbour NSW 2450) or hand delivered as per the instructions below:

2D ENTRIES: All hardcopy entries must be originals. Entries are to be clearly labelled with the title of the work, entrant's name, address, telephone number and email address in the top left-hand corner on the reverse of the work. All works must be received ready to hang unless supplied on paper in A3 or A4 size for framing by the gallery.

DIGITAL ENTRIES: Enter via email to office@nationalcartoongallery.com.au. Please supply files in 300dpi, JPEG format for either A4 (210mm x 197mm) or A3 (420mm x 297mm) printing. Works will be printed on 200gsm card at 600 dpi photo quality printing using a Canon Image Runner Advance C5240 Printer. All digital works will be matted and framed by the gallery.

SCULPTURE: Advise your intent to enter by email to office@nationalcartoongallery.com.au with details of your artwork size, weight and medium to arrange suitable delivery and storage options.

JUDGING: The organisers will appoint suitable judges. Judges will not be eligible to enter the competition. The decision of the judges will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Winners will be announced on 31 January 2020 at the presentation evening at the National Cartoon Gallery. All finalists will be advised prior to the event.

***COLLECTION:** All original artist retained works must be collected from the gallery. Alternate arrangements can be negotiated providing no costs are incurred to the gallery.
